## **Teme Leisure & Shropshire HAF (Holiday Activities & Food)**

### **Free Gym, Swimming and Food this summer for young people eligible for HAF (Holiday Activities & Food) at Teme Ludlow**

Teme Leisure Ludlow and Shropshire Council have come together to offer local young people aged 12 to 16 who are eligible for HAF free gym membership, swimming sessions and food vouchers over the Summer Holidays at Teme Leisure Ludlow.

During 22<sup>nd</sup> July to 5<sup>th</sup> September HAF eligible young people will get Free Membership, including unlimited access to

- Supervised Gym Sessions: Monday Tuesday & Wednesday 2.30pm-3.30pm
- Family Fun and Public Swim Sessions: Monday – Friday 10.30am-12pm & 1.30pm-5.30pm
- Food vouchers for Teme Leisure Ludlow Café: Opening Times Monday -Thursday 10.30am-5pm

## **Terms & Conditions and Further Information**

### **General Terms**

- 1.1 Parent / Carer must attend on 1<sup>st</sup> visit to complete registration and disclaimer forms on behalf of the student
- 1.2 Students must be aged 12-16yrs (attending secondary school)
- 1.3 Students must be eligible for the Shropshire HAF (Holiday Activities & Food) Programme. The core eligibility criteria are children and young people in receipt of benefits related free school meals and Ukrainian guests. The wider eligibility criteria is children and young people from low income households and / or living in area of high deprivation.
- 1.4 Shropshire HAF Code will be required to be provided at the time of sign up. This can be obtained via the Students school or via a professional supporting the family.
- 1.5 Students have to attend secondary school in Shropshire and / or live in the county to be eligible for the scheme.
- 1.6 Photo of the Student will be taken and held on Teme Leisure database for the duration of the offer
- 1.7 Scheme runs 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2023 – 5<sup>th</sup> September 2023
- 1.8 This scheme is non-transferable and only open to the eligible Student who signed up
- 1.9 Teme Leisure & Shropshire Council reserve the right to end this scheme early
- 1.10 Scheme limited to a maximum of 30 students. This will be allocated on a 1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> serve basis.
- 1.11 Student must check in at Reception to gain access on every visit.
- 1.12 Students must adhere to the Centre rules and adhere to staff instructions.
- 1.13 Students must be dressed appropriately for each session and activity

## **Gym Use Terms**

- 2.1 Student's may attend within the supervised session's times: Monday - Wednesday 2.30pm-3.30pm without a responsible adult.
- 2.2 Student's may attend during normal gym opening hours outside of the above supervised sessions however they must be accompanied in the Gym by a paying adult (over 18yrs) who is using and been inducted in the Gym
- 2.3 Students are only permitted to use the upstairs Gym area (access to the downstairs functional gym is not permitted).

## **Swimming Use Terms**

- 3.1 Student can access any Family Fun or Public Session. Please refer to the Teme Leisure website or App for the Swimming Timetable

## **Food Voucher Terms**

- 4.1 Food Vouchers will be issued at Reception on each visit.
- 4.2 Food Vouchers can be redeemed at Teme Ludlow Café for a meal deal (see options below) Voucher will be retained by Teme café staff
- 4.3 A maximum of 16 food vouchers per student can be given.
- 4.4 Teme Café Opening Times is Monday – Thursday 10.30am-5pm
